We are happy to report we have made it another week **without** any confirmed COVID positives in our facility. There are really no changes to how we are operating this week as it relates to the coronavirus. Below are a few updates to keep you informed as we promised.

- **Peak in Indiana** – Dr. Kristina Box, Indiana State Health Commissioner, shared yesterday that we are now not expecting a surge in Indiana until potentially near the end of April into the first few weeks of May. This means we are not completely out of the woods for letting up on restrictions and strict protocol. All visitor restrictions remain in place.
